

#### Hobart City Council wants to squeeze 7850 new residents into Sandy Bay/Mt Nelson

Hobart City Council staff have admitted that their goal is to swell the population of Sandy Bay/Mt Nelson by an extra 7850 people, an increase of 47.6%.

To achieve this massive growth HCC staff supports the relocation of the Sandy Bay UTAS campus, ignoring the views of 74% of the people of Hobart. These disclosures came during the Council's public consultation on a long-term Mt Nelson/Sandy Bay Neighbourhood Plan.

**SaveUTAS** has accused the Council of deceiving the community during this consultation process. Council staff did not reveal their true intentions until just before the closure of the public online survey on the proposed Plan.





SaveUTAS says the entire public consultation process (stakeholder meetings, community workshops and the online public survey) has been carefully contrived by HCC staff to ensure the community was not aware that the Plan would support UTAS relocation.

HCC staff made sure the UTAS move and its implications for Sandy Bay/ Mt Nelson were not discussed or explored by the community.
