Concern about the University and its management led to a parliamentary inquiry into the University of Tasmania Act 1992. By looking at whether the Act is adequate this Legislative Council inquiry will be able to consider UTAS management and decision-making, including how it came to decide to relocate without community approval, and the treatment of its academic staff. Please encourage everyone to make a submission. This can even be made anonymously where a person fears adverse consequences if identified.
